The author argues that an ideal lifespan is 75 years, emphasizing that living too long can lead to physical and mental decline, diminishing one's creativity and contribution to society. He criticizes the American obsession with prolonging life through excessive health regimens, referring to this phenomenon as the "American immortal." He also highlights the increasing prevalence of disability and dementia in old age, questioning the quality of extended life.

I partially agree with the author's viewpoint. While longevity is often regarded as desirable, the deterioration of physical and cognitive functions can worsen the quality of life. However, I think it is an exaggeration to assume that creativity and productivity always decline after 75. Some individuals, like scientists and artists, continue to make significant contributions well beyond this age. Instead of setting a fixed age limit, people should focus on maintaining a meaningful life through physical and mental engagement. A balanced approach that values both longevity and quality of life is essential.
